High Voltage Safety Act protects Georgians and their property

The next time you plan for work to be done near highvoltage power lines, look up. Are the limbs you plan to trim within 10 feet of an overhead line? Will the job you're contracting be performed under a high-voltage wire?

If so, you'll need to call the Utilities Protection Center (UPC) three days before starting the job.

It's the law, according to Georgia's High Voltage Safety Act, which was designed to protect people and property. Just as Georgians are required to call the UPC before digging to protect the public and ensure no underground utilities are damaged, they also are required to notify the UPC at least 72 hours before work begins within 10 feet of overhead high-voltage lines (more than 750 volts). The number to call is 811.

The UPC encourages property owners and contract workers to consider the duties they perform near high-voltage lines, whether it's pruning, harvesting or unloading feed. If uncertain whether work is within 10 feet of overhead lines, or if the lines are high-voltage, call the UPC at 811. The three-day notification gives them time to ensure safety precautions are in place.


Penalties for not notifying the UPC when working near overhead power lines include a misdemeanor charge that carries a fine of \$1,000 for a first offense and \$3,000 for subsequent offenses. If property damage or personal injury results from noncompliance, those responsible can be held liable for the damage or injuries, according to Georgia Code Section 46-3-33.

The UPC number to call when working near overhead lines is 811. Remember: "Stay 10 feet away, work another day." For more, visit *www. gaupc com/laws_ga_overbead.asp.*

Digger Dog makes Thomasville stop

THOMASVILLE — Digger Dog, the mascot for Georgia's Underground Utility Protection Center, visited Thomasville Thursday as part of Dig Safely Month.

Digger Dog appeared for local contractors at the Thomasville Utilities Operations Center, presented a program to the first grade students at Garrison-Pilcher Elementary School and marched in the 31st annual Rose Bud Parade.

The mascot conducts a 30-minute hands on presentation designed to teach students about critical information regarding utility line safety.

This includes why to stay away from exposed utility lines, transformers and overhead power lines, why it's important to call the Utilities Protection Center before you dig, and, why colorful utility yard flags are important.

He also brought messages about the importance of smelling gas and actingfast, and how to be safe around overhead electrical lines.

"Anyone who will be digging is required to dial 811 before beginning the project." 



Johnson competed against utility locators from nine states and Canada. The International Utility Locate Rodeo is designed to celebrate the art and science behind underground utility location. It recognizes and serves as the cornerstone promoting high quality and achievable standards in the industry.

Everyone who plans to break ground should call 811 before digging to inform their local one-call notification center, known as Utilities Protection Center Inc. in Georgia. The call is free and is the first step citizens who intend to dig must take to have a locating technician mark their property.







Macon, Georgia with Mercer University Map



Striking a single line can result in harm to yourself or someone else, costly fines and repair fees or inconvenient outages. One utility line is unintentionally struck every minute in the US.

Because of the proven success and positive results of the OAAG's PSA Program, GA-UPC is has already begun the renewal process to add more boards to their PSA campaign in 2009. Thanks to all of you that helped with the posting of this campaign! It was a true success!





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
