This format is provided for the excavator to document pertinent information before calling Georgia 811 and must be made available on site throughout the entire process of excavation. It is imperative that you fill out all relevant fields accurately and completely. The entire process is negatively impacted as a result of inadequate information provided by unprepared callers.

You must take the time to gather the correct information in order to have your request processed. Please be patient and answer all questions in the order they are asked.

It is very important that you provide accurate intersecting street information.

- Always try to give an intersecting street within a quarter mile of the main address.
- You must always provide additional intersecting streets in order to assist in proper gridding/mapping the work location. Please refrain from using major highways or interstates as cross streets.

Please take in consideration that the operator taking your call must have exact information in order to properly dispatch the ticket to the affected Georgia 811 member utilities. Whenever possible, please try to narrow the scope of the request by simply indicating exactly where you will be digging. White-lining the proposed area of excavation with white (water based) paint is the best method, however, simply indicating specific locating instructions on the locate request is appreciated. The time wasted marking unnecessary areas adversely impacts the entire industry. To review the entire law, please log onto the Georgia 811 website, www.ga811.com.
